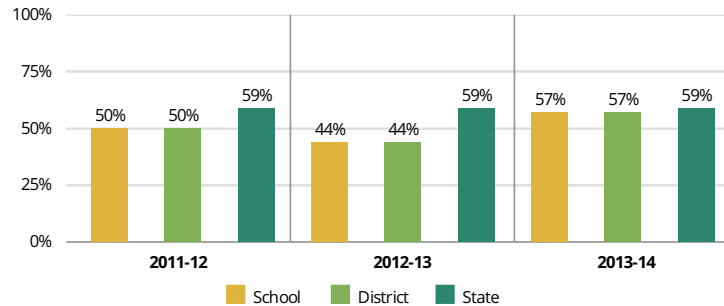
Academic Growth

The percentage of students who meet or exceed standards on the Illinois Standards Achievement Test (ISAT).

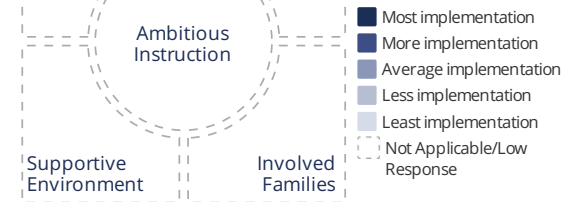

The **5Essentials Survey** allows students in grades 6-12 and all teachers to share their perspectives on essential conditions for learning. The anonymous survey consists of 5 components.



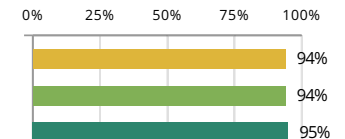

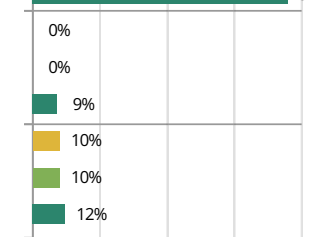

Academic Courses

Malden Grade School is single building school district that serves PK-8 regular education and a K-8 Life Skills Program. Malden Grade School staff are proud and excited to serve a student body that is diverse in background, ability, and need. Malden staff believes strongly in the vision statement that teamwork leads to individual achievement.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Malden Grade School students have access to Physical Education on a daily basis for 45 minutes. The school also has a strong relationship with the Bureau Co. Health Department which provides a variety of health related activities and programs for the students and staff.

Other Programs and Activities

Malden believes in educating the whole child. Students are exposed to Music and Art as well as Math and Language Arts. The success of a Malden child is not measured by one test on one day but rather a thoughtful evaluation of a student's entire body of work over the year including MAP test and progress monitoring tools. 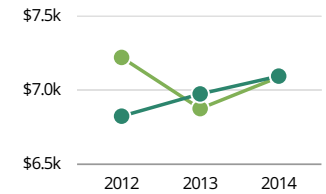
