District Finance Update

Malden CCSD #84 remains in a very strong financial situation. Our district has adequate reserves to withstand unexpected expenses and increased costs due to inflation. In the last audit the district received the highest financial rating the state issues. The rating is based on cash on hand, amount the district has borrowed, and a balanced budget.

Security Cameras have been added to both the exterior and interior of the building. While on MGS property, visitors and students will be under video surveillance. Cameras were added to increase student and staff safety.
